Join us tomorrow for Episcopal Holy Eucharist with Rev. Nancy Hopkins-Greene. The gospel this week is from Luke chapter fourteen. Jesus is having a meal at the house of a high-ranked Pharisee, and his fellow guests commit a faux pas-- they sit in the seats that are for honored guests. Jesus uses this minor gaffe to give some advice about wedding etiquette-- a bit ironic, coming from the guy who bucked tradition when he was partying in Cana, but who are we to judge?

Construction Updates

Parking: The IHSD has multiple sites of construction going on, which will continue into 2023. The IHC north parking lot is being used for their overflow. The school is aware that there may be situations where adjustments need to be made and they have indicated they will arrange for alternative parking when it is required (such as funerals, high-attendance group meetings, etc). Heather Jordan is in direct contact with the Jim Nichols, Director of Operations for IHSD. Also keep in mind that the construction for IHC has begun and parking in the south lot will be extremely limited once IHCNS returns beginning September 6th. The furthest parking lot to the south (near Camargo Club Drive) will be off limits throughout the construction period as it will be used as a staging area for the construction crew.



When visiting the church during the week, the north lot may be full. Please park in the

spots next to the building during your visit. Many are marked as handicap spots, but during the construction periods, it will be fine to use them for your visit into the building.

Elevator: We received our building permit and demolition has begun. The new elevator shaft excavation is scheduled to begin the week of August 29th.. Due to some delays with permitting, and construction of the elevator itself, the project is slated to conclude in late March.
