

Spencer, for being such a good sport and coming out to experience IHC in all its dual-denominational splendor!

In this Sunday's gospel, a Pharisee named Nicodemus seeks Jesus one evening out to talk with him about his teachings. Nicodemus presses Jesus about the idea of "rebirth," trying to draw out Jesus's meaning by excluding the literal translation: "How can anyone be born after having grown old? Can one enter a second time into the mother's womb and be born?" Jesus needles him gently, asking, "Are you a teacher of Israel, and yet you do not understand these things?"

John's gospel asserts that Nicodemus held Jesus in his regard both before this conversation and after, and goes on to say in later chapters that Nicodemus vouched for Jesus before the Sanhedrin, urging them to take an investigation of Jesus seriously before jumping to any conclusions; and still later, after Jesus's crucifixion, he arrived with embalming spices to help prepare his body for burial.
